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Tuition Fees

Financial Aid

Students participating in an exchange are registered as full-time students at Concordia University of Edmonton. Therefore, if a student is eligible to receive student loans, the student may also be eligible for funding to study outside of Canada. Students are encouraged to apply for student loan funding as early as possible. A student does not need to have been officially accepted at the host institution to apply. Additional Insurance

If a student decides to withdraw or is dismissed from a host institution and chooses to return to Concordia University of Edmonton before the completion of coursework and evaluation, a student should notify the International Office as soon as possible.

- x There is no guarantee that a student will receive credits for coursework if a student withdraws from a host institution before the completion of a course.
- x If a student must leave a host institution prematurely, all documentation of work completed abroad will be required.
